You however are getting the heads up through this newsletter. Another great wine to be released is our **“pfamous” Pinot Noir**, coming from our oldest vines on our Sunday Creek Vineyard. This is also being released at our winery for tastings and sales on our Birthday celebration weekend. As I write this letter, we are right in the middle of Vintage 2014. The grapes are ripening, being harvested, crushed and going through their different winemaking processes and finally made pristine before being bottled ready for your enjoyment now and in the “pfuture”. To help through this busy time and to gain valuable experience, we have **three International visitors** to Pfeiffer Wines this Vintage. If you look inside the newsletter, you will meet them all.
